



Paid reply postal card, message half as well as reply half, issued 1898. Both cards originally were attached to each other and were separated before sending. The cards were sent on 17 January as well on 18 January 1898 and were cancelled by a faint "CORREOS / [...]" cancel. On the back, the cards were tied by a "CORREOS / MANILA" cancel on 24 January 1898. **Only known used paid reply postal card, reply half.** Provenance message half: Arturo Aguinaga

Since, according to the decree of 8 December 1897, the postage of a domestic postcard was reduced from 2 Centavos to 1 Centavos de Peso as of 1 January 1898, the cards are overpaid.
