

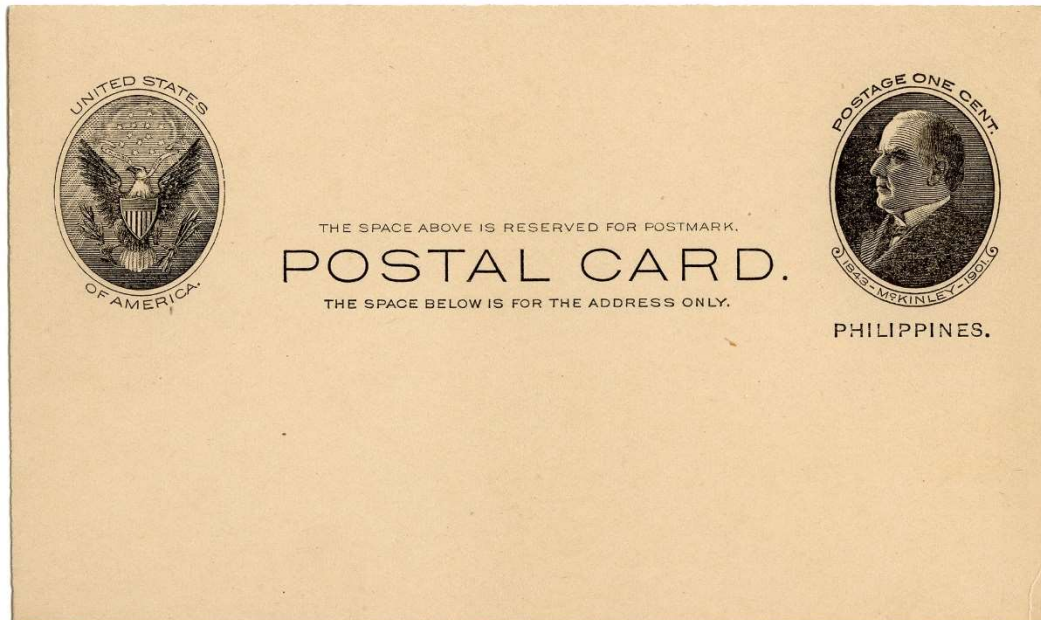

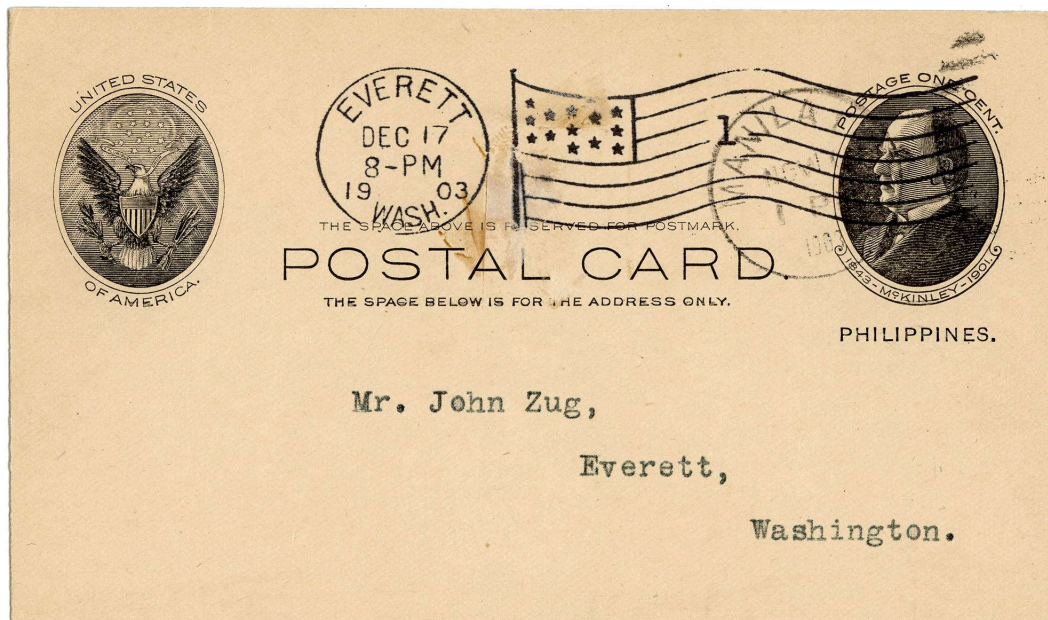
1 Cent McKinley – Overprint Type 3. Overprinted by a local printer in Washington, D.C.. The cards were shipped on 15 September 1903.

The first day of usage is 10 November 1903.

Quantity (reported): 100,000 cards.

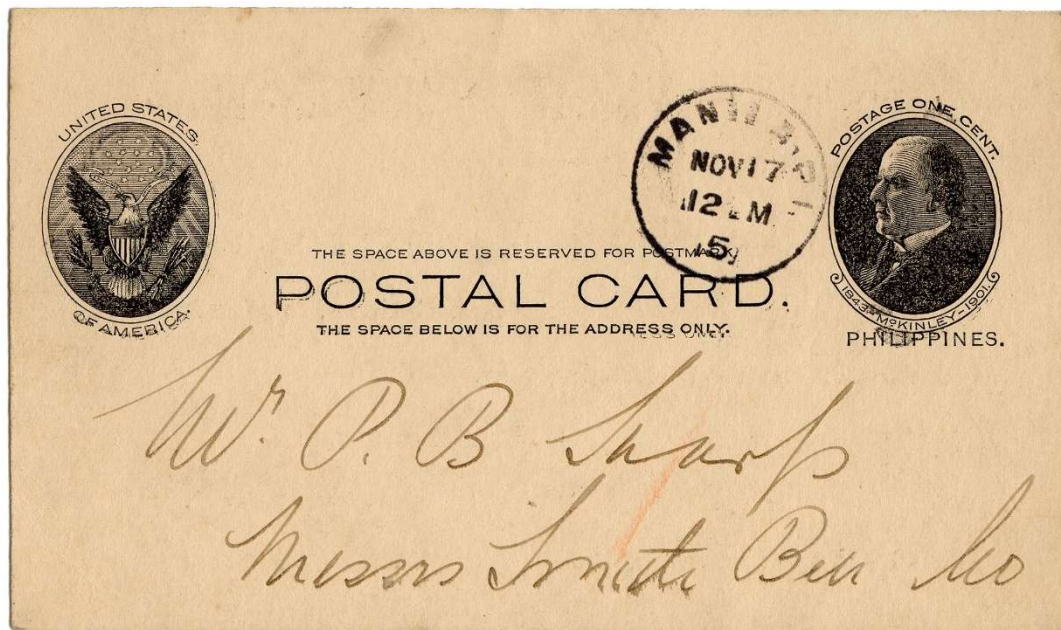


Mint card.

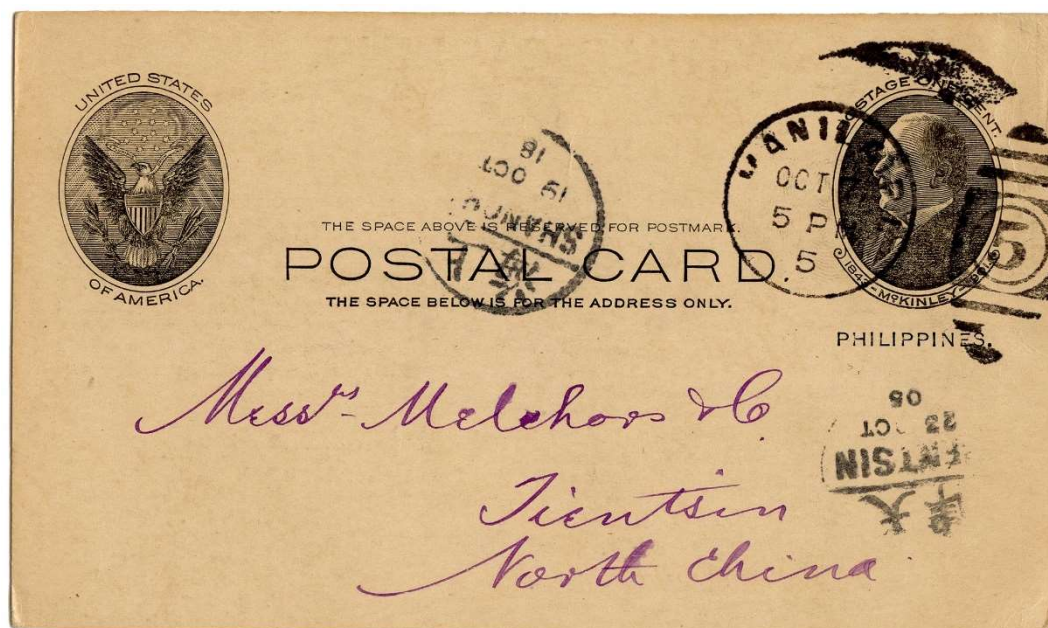


Manila 10 November 1903, to Everett, United States of America.

Manila 7 October 1905, to Tientsin, China. Receiving cancels from Shanghai and Tientsin on the front.

Privately overprinted postal card, advertisement for cheap telegraph cabling printed on the back.

Properly sent as international printed matter at 1 Cent.
