

ISSUED 1900 - 1906

2 Cents Liberty – Overprint Type 4, designed for UPU mailing. Overprinted by contractor Albert Daggett, Rumford Falls, Maine. The order for these cards was shipped on 9 July 1906.

The cards were issued in late 1906.

Quantity ordered: 10,000 cards.



Manila 18 May 1907, to Quezaltenango, Republic of Guatemala.

A postmark from New Orleans, United States of America documents the transit. On its further journey it was carried by a vessel of the Royal Mail Steamship Company from New Orleans to Livingston, Guatemala. Upon arrival it got a transit mark on 4 July 1907. Quezaltenango receiving cancel dating 7 July 1907 on the front.

The cards were used only for a short time before overprinted issues were withdrawn from sale and replaced by the new centavos postal card designs. Unsold stocks were destroyed as remainders.

As a large proportion of the issue was destroyed, this type of postal card is **one of the rarest and most sought-after in the collecting field Philippines.**
