

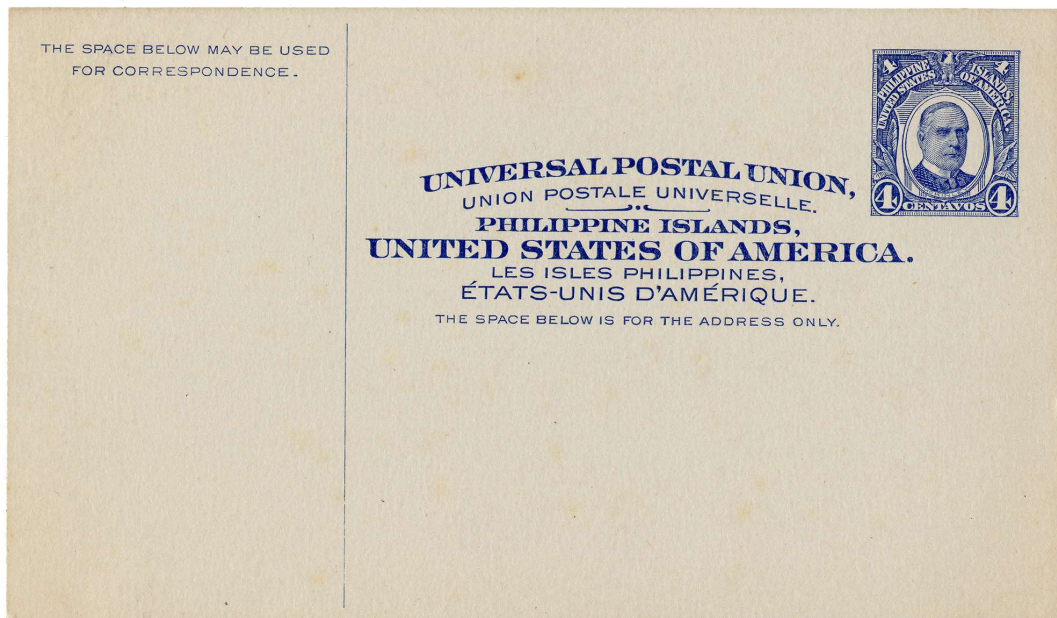

The cards were issued in July 1911.

Quantity issued: 60,000 cards.



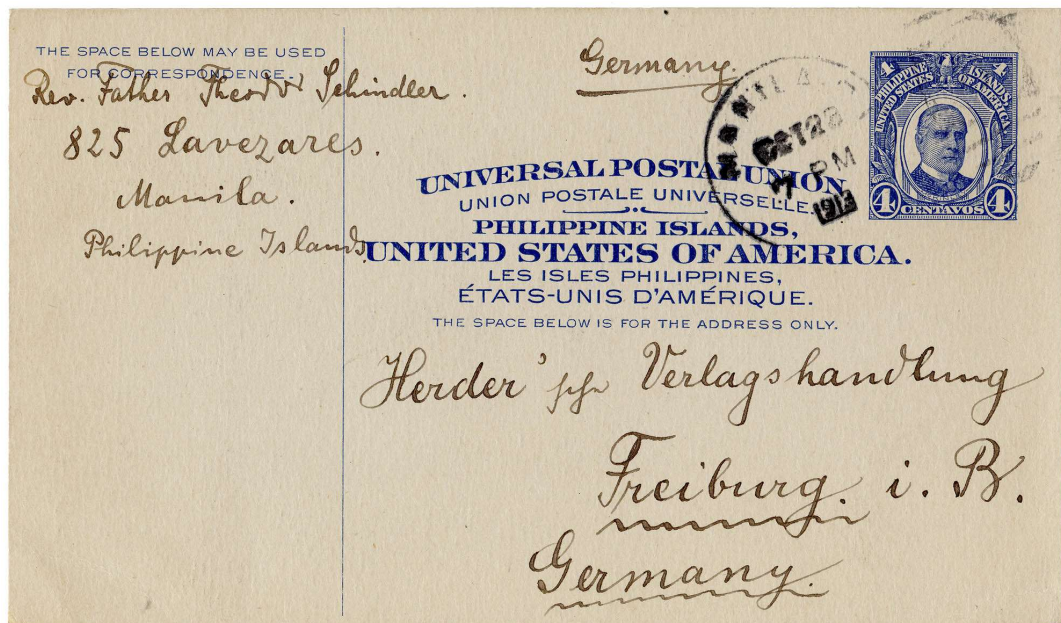
Mint card, light blue card stock.



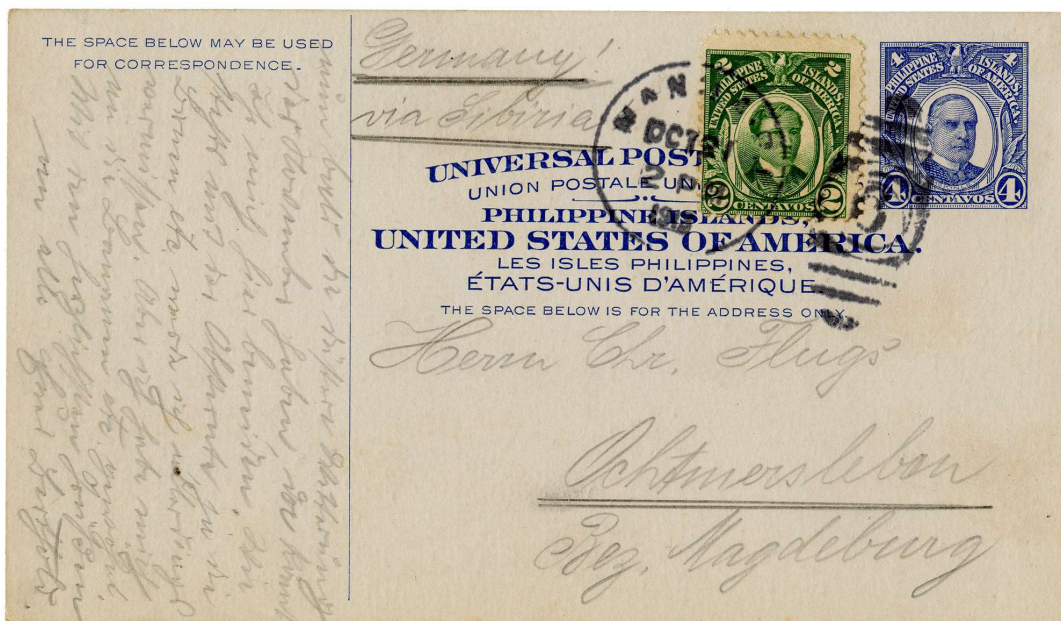
Manila 2 January 1914, to Tientsin, French concession in China.

Chinese postmarks from Shanghai and Tientsin and a French postmark from Tientsin document the transit.

The recipient was a French soldier from the Arsenal de l'Est in Tientsin, **rare destination**.



Manila 23 October 1913, to Freiburg im Breisgau, German Empire.



Manila 21 October 1913, to Ochtmersleben, German Empire.
