




2 Centavos Rizal, Official Business. Engraved and overprinted by the U.S. Bureau of Engraving and Printing, Washington, D.C.. The overprinted "O.B." is 4 mm high.

The cards were issued in July 1939.

Quantity issued: 215,462 cards.




Mint card on canary card stock. The card stock used varies from canary to buff color.
The cards exist with normal as well as short dividing line.




Manila 29 July 1939, to Uppsala, Kingdom of Sweden.
Official usage of this uprated card on canary card stock.


Earliest reported usage of this card.

Manila 28 December 1939, to Blackburn, United Kingdom. Official usage of this card.
An official stamp at 4 Centavos was added to the card on buff card stock.



Manila 28 August 1940, to Copenhagen, Kingdom of Denmark. Official usage of this card.
An official stamp at 4 Centavos was added to the card on buff card stock with short dividing line.
German censor marks from Berlin were applied on front.

The content of the card deals with the shipping problems of publications resulting from the war in Europe.
