*Note: The **Veteranos de la Revolución** (Veterans of the Revolution) was a welfare-membership society created to care for registered surviving members, officers and soldiers and their families who fought in the Philippine Revolution first against the Spaniards, then against the Americans. Department chapters have been created in other provinces and towns. The Tondo unit (No. 6) under the Department of Manila is the largest in terms of surviving membership. (143 members in 1906)*
