VIA AIR MAIL

A proclamation in November 1992 placed a surcharge on all types of mails to operate between 16 November and 28 February 1993, a period of 105 days; 25c for domestic mail and 1peso for international items. Although obligatory taxes had been applied previously in the Philippines, the additional domestic cost was not well received and a Manila businessman took the Government to the High Court who decided the surcharge was unconstitutional. Therefore the stamps were withdrawn for sale on 1 February 1993 (only 78 days).

The above stamps were therefore required for all mail as a postal tax stamps between 16 Nov 1992 and 1 Feb 1993. The stamps were re-issued and became valid for postage in their own right on 14 Jun 1993.
