Manila Printed Issue of 1922



Depositor only paid for this stamp that were affixed to the passbook The only 'A' stamps that survived came from UNREDEEMED passbooks with usually low values



The 'B' stamps were affixed to the original deposit slip forwarded to bank headquarters in Manila Examples of these survived much better perhaps liberated during WWII except for the rare P500



The 'C' stamps were affixed to the duplicate deposit slip retained by the local POSTMASTER 'C' stamp survival is uncommon and also usually low values

- ★ Each set of 'A–B–C' stamps had the same serial number
- ★ This procedure was followed through calendar year 1929
- ★ Deposit slips dated 1928 and 1929 can have both this 1922 issue and the next issue on them
