However the Singapore back-stamp proves it went by the Dutch airline KLM.

Ship from Manila to Singapore.

Rate

Franking 1P 14c - 94c on front and five more 4c stamps on reverse.

98c airmail; plus

16c letter to foreign country.

This 1933 airmail rate of 98c per 20g to Europe did not depend on the airline or the city where the flight began.
