## Letters to Great Britain

From the beginning of Jan 1934, Philippines mail could be carried by air by the British planes from Singapore. There is usually no date-stamp after Manila so it is difficult to tell which airline carried it.

Regardless of airline the rate to Britain was higher than to the rest of Europe.
