## **By Internal Airmail in Philippines**

Until 1936, airmail for overseas, was charged an extra fee if carried internally by air. Both covers went from Baguio to Manila by air, then by sea to Singapore, and then by air.



Baguio 13 June 1934, to Sweden

Upper Cover. KLM Pelikaan left Singapore on 21 June. On KLM's summer route, the flight left Athens and went via Budapest. Budapest backstamp 27 June 1934. Surface Budapest to Sweden.

Baguio 21 Nov 1935, to England

Rate - Upper Cover 1P 58c.

16c (per 15gr) was the rate for internal Philippines airmail up until 1937.

1P 26c air from Singapore to Europe except UK, per 20g.

16c letter rate to foreign country.

Lower Cover Backstamp Manila 21 Nov 10AM.

> Rate Franked 94 centavos.

16c Philippines internal airmail plus 2c internal surface.

60c air to Europe for 6-10 gr (30c per 5gr).

16c letter rate to foreign country.
