## Special Flights from the Philippines (1935-36)

There were various one-off flights from the Philippines. Mail carried on these flights was philatelic. Many of the covers in this section then proceeded in the normal mail system.

## **British Royal Air Corps Survey Flight**

These letters were carried on a survey flight from Manila to Singapore with a stop at Labuan. From Singapore the upper cover went by air, while the lower cover went onwards by sea.
