

First Flight between the Philippines and Japan

This flight was sponsored by newspapers in Osaka and Tokyo.

Postcard addressed to the stop-over in Taiwan, then a part of Japan

The flight stopped at Taihoc in northern Taiwan.

The purple postmark at the left recognises the inauguration of President Quezon on 15 Nov.
The flight left Manila on the next day, 16 Nov.

Like so many items on this flight, it was returned to its sender.

The Taihoku postmark shows the date the item left this town, 2 Dec.
