Sender typed "VIA CLIPPER" at lower left, meaning via HK. Manila stamped HK mark at lower right.

Postage of 72c paid for the route via Singapore for 6-10g. Manila crossed out one HK mark and overstamped the other with a Singapore mark. The cover was then struck with another Singapore mark.
