Higher weight airmail via Singapore Eight-times rate to Netherlands

The rate is slightly different to the rates table. It is possible that the postal clerks incorrectly calculated the component for foreign letter postage.



Manila 1 April 1939, to Amsterdam

Rate

2P 72c, registered letter weighing up to 40 grams, and over 35 grams.

Airmail postage = $2P \cdot 40c = eight \times 30c$.

Foreign Letter Postage = 12c. I think it should have been 18c, being 12c for first 20g, and 6c for next 20g.

Registration = 20c.

Two more purple boxed "Registered / Postal Station No. 3 / Manila P.I / undated".

Purple cds "Registry Section / Apr 1 1939 / Manila Post-Office".
