

**Endorsed to fly by KLM  
Addressed to Britain**

Mail via Singapore went by the British carrier Imperial, unless endorsed to go by Dutch KLM. It is natural that senders would prefer mail addressed to Britain to go by the British airline.

These are **the only covers** to Britain endorsed to go by KLM known to the exhibitor.
