

## New Airmail Rate for Postcards

Postal cards sent by air from the Philippines are very scarce until after World War 2.



Manila 3 Feb 1940, to Amsterdam

### Route

- By sea to Singapore.
- By Imperial to London.
- By surface to destination.

### Rate

34c.

Regular postage for a post card to a foreign country = 6c since 1936, half the letter rate.

28c per 5g, by air from Singapore to Europe since 1 Jan 1940.

### Markings

PASSED / FOR / TRANSMISSION - Singapore censor mark.

The Jusqu'à bars were applied at London, to indicate the letters will go by surface to the destination.
