

Pan-Am Clipper to Guam

First Flight Covers with different rates

Following advice in the U.S. Postal Bulletin of 31 October 1935,
the sender of the upper philatelic cover also paid the Philippines regular postage.

The procedure was to indicate on the envelope the airmail sector ("Manila to Guam" or "Philippines to Guam")
and the letter would be sent by surface from Guam to U.S.
