

World War II Airmail via the Philippines (1939-41)

From Netherlands East Indies via Manila to USA

Mail from Netherlands East Indies was sent to Manila, to connect with the Pan-Am service to San Francisco.

The upper cover went by sea to Manila, and was posted on board a ship.
