Route

From Haarlem by train to Köln (Cologne).
 German DLH air service to Lisbon.
 Pan-Am FAM 18 to NY.
 Air to San Francisco.
 Pan-Am clipper to Manila.

On reverse

Köln cds 2 Sept.
 German censor sealing paper and censor stamps.

Rate

97½ cents, up-to-5 grams
 = 12½c basic (per 20g)
 plus 85c airmail (per 5g).
