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**Manila North Airport** was the country's first commercial airport in Avenida Extension, Caloocan. It started its operation in the 1930s initially by the Lopez family-owned Iloilo-Negros Air Express Co, Inc. (INAEC), and the Philippine Aerial Taxi Co. (PATCO), precursor of Philippine Air Lines (PAL). The devastation brought by WWII forced the airfield to cease operations. The area that was once occupied by Manila North Airport had been repurposed as residential subdivision, Grace Park, in the 1950s. Jose Rizal who had crossed continents on ship during his travels would have likely reached more, and farther, places had airplanes been introduced during his time.
