Galleons are the Spanish trading ships that link Manila to the outside world. Friar Andres de Urdaneta's return route from Philippines to Mexico via Acapulco in 1565 commences the galleon route.

In 1626, the safe voyage of galleon is attributed to an image of Mary from Mexico, the *Nuestra Señora de la Paz y Buen Viaje*.
