## MONUMENT FOR RIZAL

In 1901, the US Philippine Commission approves Act No. 243 that grants the right to use public land in Luneta to build a monument to commemorate the memory of Jose Rizal.

The monument design is awarded to Richard Kissling, a Swiss sculptor, for his *Motto Stella* (Guiding Star), in 1908. The Rizal Monument is finally unveiled on December 30, 1913 in Luneta, on Rizal's 17th death anniversary.
