



ESCOLTA

Calle de la Escolta in Manila is created in the 16th century during the Spanish colonial period, and develops into a commercial area with upmarket department stores and imposing architectural establishments in the 20th century.



Department Stores (Rambler, CL Alcan and Heacock's) along Escolta have availed of the special permit from the Bureau of Posts to overprint stamps with their company initials, used between 1926-1930s.
