



ZEPPELIN

In the early 20th century, German Count Ferdinand von Zeppelin pioneers the invention of the rigid airship, popularly known as "zeppelin".

Zeppelins are first flown commercially in 1910, and are extensively used as bombers during the WWI.

After the war, Zeppelins make transatlantic flights, but cease to operate following the "Hindenburg disaster" in 1937.
