





WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE

Philippine women's suffrage movement starts with the Asociacion Feminista Filipina, founded by Concha Felix de Calderon in 1905, and the Liga Nacional de Damas Filipinas, founded by Rosa Sevilla Alvero in 1916. With the ardent support of First Lady Aurora Quezon, the "Woman's Suffrage Plebiscite Bill" is signed by Pres. Manuel L. Quezon in 1937.
