CORREGIDOR

Corregidor serves as a fortress of defense, a penal institution, a Customs inspection station, and a signal outpost to Manila during the Spanish colonial period. During the American period, Corregidor is fortified with a network of tunnels and formidable array of defensive armament. Corregidor becomes the culmination of the Japanese campaign for the conquest of the Philippines in May 1942.
