New Postage Stamps on Sale In Manila, Other Cities on April 1

New 2- and 5-centavo postage stamps will be placed on sale stamped on that day on covers beginning April 1, at the windows of the money order section and envelopes, provided each coand of the Manila post office, and in the post offices in Baguio ver or envelope is affixed with city, Cebu city, Davao city and Legaspi, Albay, the director of at least one 5-centavo new stamp the Bureau of Communications announced yesterday.





Envelopes embossed stamps of the 5-centavo denomination will also be placed on sale on the same date in Manila These stamped envelopes were the former 2-centavo stampto one hundred (100) pieces of velopes properly addressed. each kind to each purchaser.

New Postage Stamps...

An appropriate cachet will be dresses of both the sender and addressee, clearly written in ink or typewritten.
