## New Postage Stamps on Sale In Manila, Other Cities on April 1

New 2- and 5-centavo postage stamps will be placed on sale beginning April 1, at the windows of the money order section and of the Manila post office, and in the post offices in Baguio city, Cebu city, Davao city and Legaspi, Albay, the director of the Bureau of Communications announced yesterday.



The New Stamps

Envelopes embossed with stamps of the 5-centavo denomination will also be placed on sale on the same date in Manila only. These stamped envelopes were the former 2-centavo stamped envelopes.

In order to give many patrons a chance to buy these stamps and stamped envelopes, their sale on the first day will be limited to one hundred (100) pieces of each kind to each purchaser.

An appropriate cachet will be stamped on that day on covers and envelopes, provided each cover or envelope is affixed with at least one 5-centavo new stamp and bears the names and addresses of both the sender and addressee, clearly written in ink or typewritten. Philatelic covers and envelopes properly addressed, as stated above, and bearing such stamps should be presented at windows Nos. 22 and 23 of the Manila Post Office where such covers will be stamped with the cachet.

Those presenting more than 10 envelopes or covers for collection purposes to be stamped with the special cachet should call for such envelopes the next day.

The post offices in Baguio City, Cebu City, Davao City, and Legaspi, Albay, will also stamp on the aforesaid date similar cachets on first day covers and envelopes properly addressed as stated.
