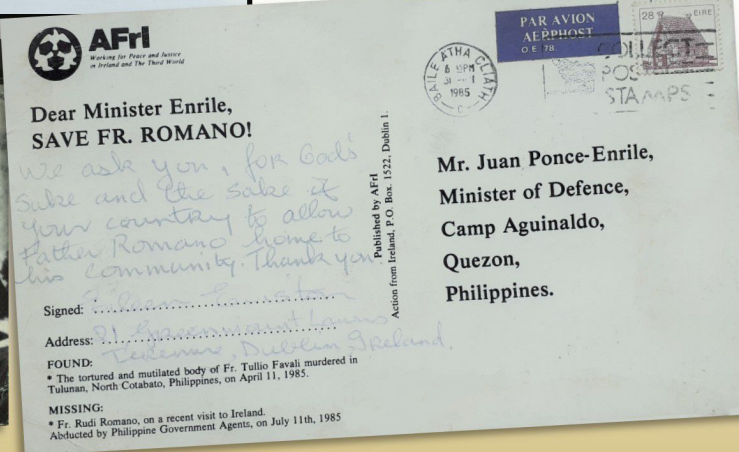
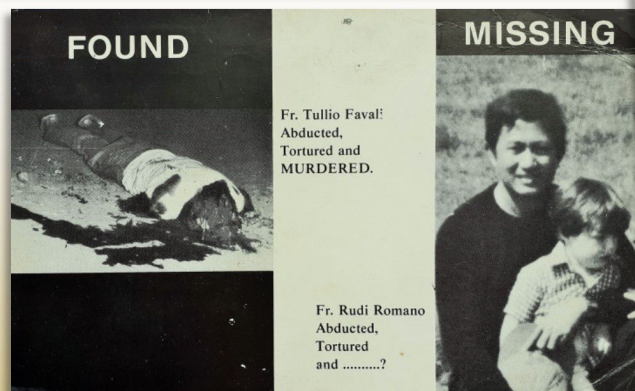


THEOLOGY OF STRUGGLE
