

1925 "LAMBERT" IMPERFORATE ISSUE

Philippine postal regulations permitted imperforate orders of the then regular postage issues to deter theft. (Min. order - 10,000 Pesos; US \$ 5,000). Only the Lambert Company ordered such, in denominations of 2 Centavos to 10 Pesos, as well as the 20 Centavos Special Delivery issue.
