The Boy Scouts of the Philippines was organised as the Philippine Council, Boy Scouts of America in 1923 and formally created on October 31, 1936 by Commonwealth Act No 111. On October 1, 1946, it was accorded membership in the International Scout Conference (now World Scout Conference). It is the largest youth organisation in the Philippines which aims to develop good citizenship among boys by forming their characters, training them in the habits of observation and self-reliance, including loyalty and thoughtfulness for others, and promoting their physical, mental and spiritual development.
