

## 1861 QUEEN ISABELLA II ISSUE

On January 1, 1861, a new 5 cuartos vermilion stamp was issued in Manila, printed in lithograph by M. Perez y hijos of Manila. The design was similar to that the letterings around the head were issued for interior use to be used for printed form the equivalent of existence of 10 cuartos



the 1857 (?) issue except were bigger and the pearls less distinct. Although only, it was also allowed outbound mail (a pair to 10 cuartos) due to the non-stamps printed in Spain.
