

1863 QUEEN ISABELLA II ISSUE

Issued on January 1, 1863, in sheets of 128 (13 x 10) with the bottom row having eight stamps only, instead of ten, and showing two blank spaces at both ends. As with some of the previous issues, this was lithographed by M. Perez y hijos of Manila. The denominations used were in compliance with the Royal Decree of December 7, 1853, all for domestic use. A total of 5000 complete sets were made available.

These stamps can be differentiated from the 1862 issue by the "colon (:)" after "CORREOS" on the upper inscription, instead of just a "period (.)".

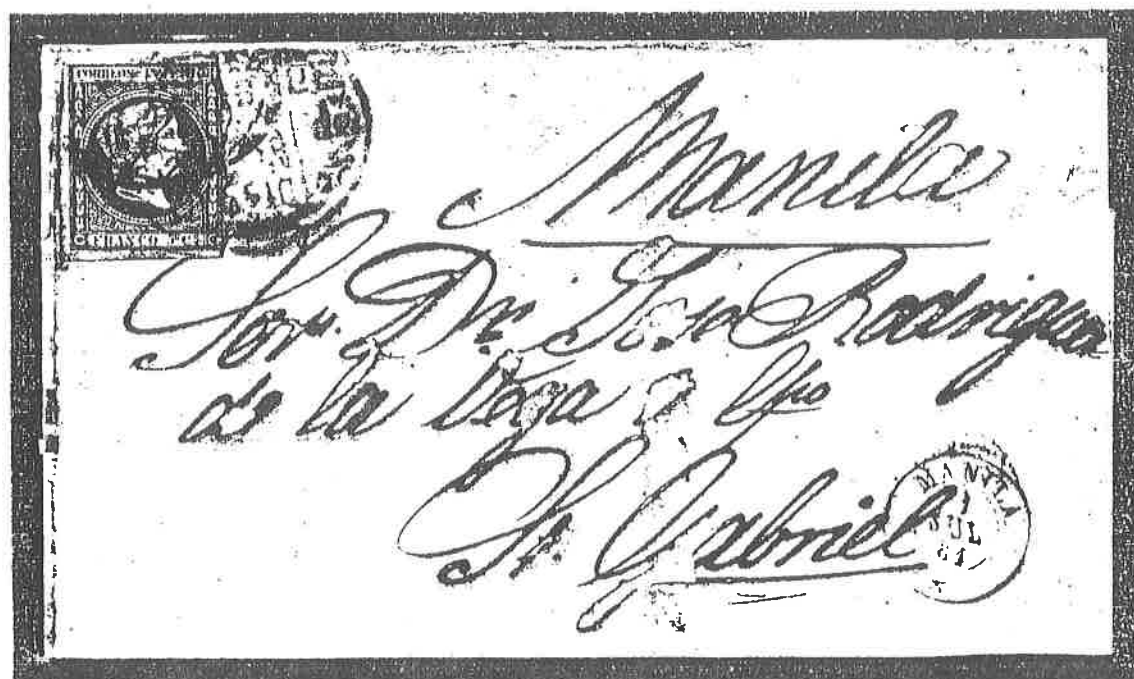
