1874 "PEACE" ISSUE

Upon the abdication of King Amadeus on February 11, 1873, a provisional Republic was formed known as the First Spanish Republic. It ruled from February 12, 1873, to December 31, 1874. Stamps with the design of an allegorical figure of a seated woman, symbolizing "Peace" were issued. Typographed by Fabrica Nacional de Timbre of Madrid, in sheets of $100 \ (10 \ x \ 10)$, perforated 14. The die used was engraved by Eugenio Julio Jover.
