On account of the great variety of surcharged stamps employed at this time for postage, and the innumerable official decrees governing the matter, the post office officials were actually ignorant of what stamps were authorized for postage, and what for telegraph purposes. In the end, all stamps with "Recargo de Consumos" surcharge, were sent to the provinces and used for postage. Only the 2 4/8c were on sale in Manila, while the rest of the values, in the provinces.
