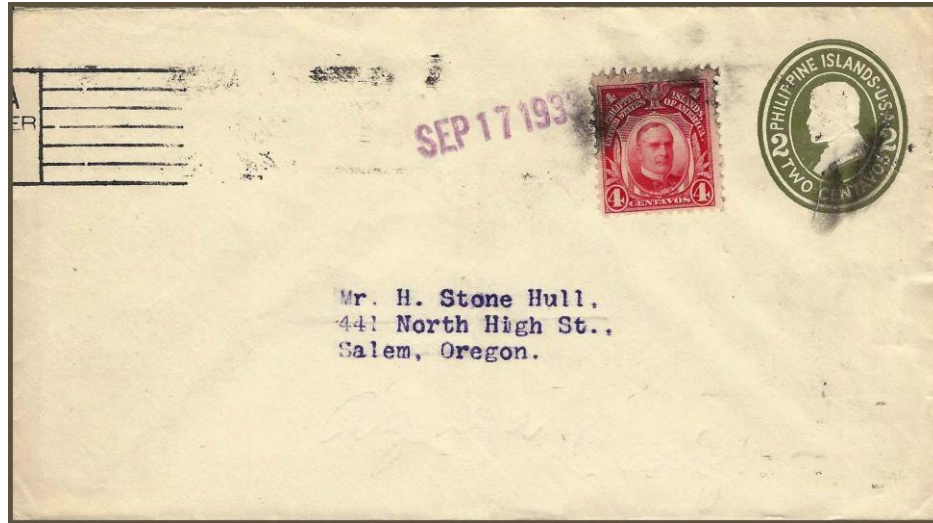


L. Printed Masonic Card on Back Flap of PSE

P. O. Box 2626 address printed in 2 lines with Masonic symbol on top and printed in blue color; on 2c Rizal PSE issue of 1933 (UPSS# 45). The emblematic symbol of the Square and Compasses is often used in Masonic rituals. The Square is an emblem of virtue in which we must "*square our actions by the square of virtue with all mankind*". The Compasses exemplify our wisdom of conduct - the strength to "*circumscribe our desires and keep our passions within due bounds*". The letter "G" in the middle of the Square and Compasses refers to God. When these 2 Masonic tools are placed together with God (the Creator) as our central focal point, peace and harmony are the results.
